

LGV CATEGORY C

Course Requirements

Prior to starting the course you need to apply for your provisional license, which is free of charge. To enable you to do this you have to have a medical. You can either do a medical with your own doctor or contact us and we can sort a medical for you

You will need to send off a medical form (D4) with your application form (D2) to the DVLA, or you can take it to the DVLA and hand it in yourself. The address for the DVLA - DVLA, Long View Rd, Morrision, Swansea, SA6 7JL

This application normally takes up to about 10 days to process. Only when you receive your license back from the DVLA with the provisional entitlement on can you proceed onto the next step.

You will then need to study and sit a theory test which includes a multiple choice test, hazard perception test and a CPC test. These test's are also called module 1a & 1b (Multiple choice & Hazard Perception) and module 2 (CPC). Once you have passed your theory tests you are then able to continue with the practical training course.
